Kind of Sentence	End Punctuation	Example
(Declarative or Imperative) statement or command	period (.)	Look at this tree. It is more than 500 years old.
(Interrogative) question	question mark (?)	Have you ever planted a tree?
(Exclamatory) exclamation	exclamation mark (!)	What a remarkable life!
