Lesson 5: The *y* to *i* Rule

Rule a: When a word ends in a consonant followed by y, change the *y* to *i* before adding a suffix.

Rule b: When a word ends with a vowel followed by y, the word does not change before a suffix is added.

Rule c: Words that end in *y* do not change when a suffix beginning with *i* (*ing, ish, ist*) is added.
